



## Should You Send Them to School?



It's often difficult for parents to know whether their children are too sick to attend classes. Here are some general guidelines.

### Symptoms

Fever measured orally is above 100°		Keep at Home
Vomits more than once		Keep at Home
Infrequent diarrhea		Send to School
Ear infection; no pain		Send to School
Minor cold: runny nose, cough, sneezing, sore throat		Send to School
Infestation of scabies, lice (After treatment begins)		Send to School
Cold sores (Sore covered)		Send to School
Strep throat (After 24 hours of medication)		Send to School
Undiagnosed skin rash		See a Doctor
Eye infection		See a Doctor
Flu: body aches, fever, headache		Keep at Home
Vague "I don't feel good" symptoms		Send to School
